your veterinarian

1. What kind of written instructions or booklet for skin health can you provide?

- Ask about over the counter (OTC) tick and flea medication you can/cannot give your pet
- Take notes about all the medications and supplements dispensed

2. Can I supplement my pet's dry food with canned foods and treats?

- Discuss how food affects your pet's allergies

3. What is the best way (email/phone) to reach you or your hospital if I have any follow-up questions regarding our discussion today?

- Ask if you need a follow-up appointment
- Ask if a reminder email or notice will be sent

4. Is there a therapeutic food like Hill's® Prescription Diet® brand pet food you can recommend for my pet's skin health?

- Ask about special nutritional concerns for your pet and how the recommended food will take care of those nutritional concerns
